The Kiwanis Club of Ewing Township, through the EWING KIWANIS SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION, annually awards scholarships to EWING RESIDENTS who are planning to pursue post secondary education at an accredited four year College/University, community college or New Jersey vocational-technical school.

The Kiwanis Club of Ewing Township administers the **George A. Berrell Memorial Scholarship** to a member of the Ewing H.S. Key Club and the Kiwanis Foundation Scholarship to a student having high attainment. The scholarships have been awarded to academic achieving students who have made a significant contribution to their school and township community by participating and providing leadership to service, religious, academic and sports organizations.

The Kiwanis award scholarships on the basis of the following criteria.

1. Completion of the attached application (One application will provide eligibility for all Kiwanis scholarships).
2. A completed essay on volunteerism per instructions within the application.
3. An OFFICIAL high school transcript forwarded directly to the chairman of the scholarship committee. The transcript should include academic progress through the seventh semester including the seventh semester class rank.
4. Three letters of recommendation are to be mailed directly to the chairman of the scholarship committee. One letter should be from a teacher, the second from an organization/club advisor and the third from a non-relative person of your choice.
5. TO BE ELIGIBLE ONLY FOR THE GEORGE A. BERRELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP YOU MUST BE AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF A KEY CLUB SPONSORED BY THE KIWANIS CLUB OF EWING TOWNSHIP.
6. Eligibility for Ewing Kiwanis Foundation Scholarship does not require participating in a Key Club.

The application, supporting letters of recommendation and official transcripts are to be forwarded directly to the chairman of the Scholarship Foundation. All submitted materials will become the property of the Kiwanis Scholarship Foundation. The materials will be retained until September 30th of the year in which the scholarships are awarded. The decisions of the Foundation Board will be final.

All monetary awards will be given directly to the students.

This year, 2012, the Kiwanis Foundation will award one **George A. Berrell Memorial Scholarship** in the amount of \$1,000 and one Ewing Kiwanis Foundation Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000. Last year the Foundation awarded two \$1,000 scholarships and an additional \$500 foundation scholarship.
